APPLICATION FOR LICENSE AS AN ADVANCED PRACTICE REGISTERED NURSE

I. GENERAL INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTION:

- a. Select the area(s) of specialization you want to apply for.
- b. Upload birth certificate, marriage certificate (if applicable),
- c. Upload U.S. passport type (2"x2" size) photos with white background taken within the past 6 months and must have a visible signature on the front bottom portion of each photo. Colored background will NOT be accepted.
- d. Upload copy of current APRN license.
- e. Upload copy of National Certification
- f. **Licensure fee of \$300.00 payable to "NMI BON or NMI Board of Nursing".**
- g. **Endorsement applicants ONLY:**
 1. Temporary license is issued for 90 days while waiting completion of all requirements and the fee is **\$90.00**.
 2. Letter of Good Standing from your employer within the past 5 years.
- h. Copy of Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) License if any.

II. SPECIALTY VALIDATION. ALL DOCUMENTATION MUST BE UPLOADED DIRECTLY FROM YOUR SCHOOL. All areas of specialization have different requirements.

- A. Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist (C. R. N. A.)
 1. Proof of current/active certification by the American Association of Nurse Anesthetists Council on Certification.
 2. Official transcript from college/university showing a graduate degree conferred and the nursing specialty listed.
- B. Certified Nurse Midwife (C. N. M.)
 1. Proof of current/active certification by the American College of Nurse Midwives.
 2. Official transcript from college/university showing a graduate degree conferred and the nursing specialty listed.
- C. Clinical Nurse Specialist (C. N. S.)
 1. Official transcript from college/university showing a graduate degree conferred and the nursing specialty listed.
 2. Proof of current/active certification by a nationally recognized certification agency as a Clinical Nurse Specialist. Subspecialties of nursing, i.e. RN First Assistant do not generally meet the CNS requirement. Call the Board if you have any questions.
- D. Nurse Practitioner (N. P.)
 1. Copy of your transcript, or certificate documenting completion of a Nurse Practitioner program. ("Nurse Practitioner" must appear somewhere on this documentation.)
 2. Proof of current/active certification by a nationally recognized certification agency.
 3. Official transcript from college/university showing a graduate degree conferred and the nursing specialty listed.
